#### Announcement for Teens Ages 13-15

Fifteen teams of girls will be selected to observe wildlife, explore the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem, and view breathtaking scenery while learning about science and discovering the hidden treasures found only in nature.

#### Picture It

Spend a week hiking and canoeing through the Grand Teton National Park and the Bridger-Teton National Forest, working with young and adventurous field instructors at the Teton Science Schools. Observe nature's most intriguing creatures! Live among the pronghorn antelope, bison, coyotes, and ospreys! Participate in national bird-banding research and keep track of your wildlife and ecological discoveries in your own handmade journal. Explore environmental careers through hands on experiences with women professionals. Design an environmental project to implement back home to share your new skills and knowledge with your friends, family, council and community.

#### Be It

- Interested in science, nature, ecology and wildlife biology
- Able to work well in a team and get along with others
- Committed to designing and implementing a project to share your experience with your friends, family, council and community within one year after the event
- Partners may NOT be immediate relatives. (Sisters, step-sisters, aunts, cousins are not permitted.)

### Plan It

- July 20-27, 2007
- Participants must be registered Girl Scouts ages 13-15 at the time of the event.

### Get It

- A list of equipment will be provided (e.g. a warm sleeping bag and sturdy hiking boots) after you're accepted.

### \$ It

- **\$563.00**; Event fee covers all program expenses. Participants are responsible for round-trip airfare to/from Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Applicants must apply as a team (two girls) from the same council, and cannot be immediate relatives—see above. Individual girl applications will not be considered.
- Applicants must use the *Girl Scout 2007 destinations Application Form* and the *Reference Form* at [www.studio2b.org/escape/destinations/](http://www.studio2b.org/escape/destinations/) and submit their application forms together to their council by their council's deadline.
- Councils must complete a *Council Application Form* (attached) and submit it as a cover sheet with all team application forms to Girl Scouts of Northeast Georgia by December 1, 2006.
