Midland RockHounds Campout Rules, Timelines and Restrictions

First of all thank you for contributing your time and effort to the Midland RockHounds this season. Your attendance and support helps professional baseball thrive in the Permian Basin. Each season we have several youth groups that are allowed to camp out on the field after a specific game. This season the Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and Indian Guides and Princesses will take part in a campout on the field at Citibank Ballpark. Due to the fact that each of these campouts are schedule prior to a game the following day and the fragile grass that has already withstood half of a season, I wanted to make a list for everyone so that they would know ahead of time what is and isn't allowed on the field. Also the campout will only be in the outfield. **The infield area and dugouts are off limits.** We ask that you are out of the ballpark the next morning by 9 AM, the gate along the 1st base side will be left open for you to come and go if you need to.

Allowed

Sleeping Bags
Pillows

Flashlights
Blankets

Not Allowed

Campfires
Tents of any kind
Lanterns
No Coolers (unless left in the seated area)
Electrical or battery powered heaters or burners
Lawn Chairs
Air Mattresses
Cots
Any sort of stakes

If you plan to use bug spray please put this on in the concourse or seated areas.

Also a movie can be watched on the video board after the game. We ask for a small one time \$25.00 fee for the use of the equipment and to pay a technician to run the board that late at night. We can accommodate VHS or DVD of any movie.
